Hi Skott,

Lovely to meet you today. I've included details of John from FCAMHS who will be offering us a consultation in January for axel and his Social Workers email for easier communication.

Jake I've included you just for reference. From today's meeting there is defo some further information that needs exploring from a mental health point of view. I.e. no evidence to suggest that he is being bullied which was his rational for committing the offence and school have investigated this, has made statements in school about teachers poisoning his food and other bits and bobs that may indicated possible Psychosis. Skott will aim to see him in the next week. Skott, if you need any info from a criminal justice point of view, then please contact either Jake or myself and we will support as best we can.

Axel arrested for carrying dangerous weapon, a knife, baseball bat which he had modified to have a better grip. Assaulting [DPA]. Went to attack [DPA] who he been bullied by previously.

He stated he had no intention to use knife.

Axel has been Viewing inappropriate content online in relation to terrorism. Aggressively denied he did this to the police. Laughing throughout the interview.

Mum did not challenge behaviour.

Dad there the first day

Mum there 2nd day. Very quiet. had been Hiding knives so Axel can't use them.

Seized computers, phones.

Custody sergeants struggled to get hold of dad reluctant to engage.

Axel spoke to ChildLine and told them he took a knife into school on 10 separate occasions. ChildLine spoke to police.

21st Jan FCAMHS appointment has been provisionally made.

School:

Axel no SEN concerns after round robin

Stated to school he wanted to Stab [DPA]

No ideology of being arrested or consequences of this.

Dion [DPA] / wheelchair- no concerns

Axel range have put him on ASC waitlist.

Axel thinks he has ADD after performing his own research.

ACORNS:

Very emotionless- Mum and Dad Emotionless.

Searching school shootings in America.

Focused on one boy bullying him- but no evidence of this. Dad adamant that boy was picking on him.

School checking him for any sharps. Is being checked by a metal detector.

No eye contact with anyone.

Was saying boys picking on him but they were trying to befriend him.

Took him to Chester Zoo- 27th Nov- only day where he was happy, 'normal' interactions.

Orchestrating people to do things.

Can very easily manipulate situations and then lie about what happened.

Parenting 2000 -Dad paying for this.

Social Care:

Displays obvious ASD traits.

Does his own research. No emotional range. Only sad or angry. No positivity. No facial expression.

Concerned about parents- Axel has a lot of control. mum and Dad Tried to

challenge- but met with negativity and aggression from Axel..
Dad is very quiet. Seems both parents are struggling.
Speaks with Venom about Dion. Laughs inappropriately. Family value
education. Presented well.
No concerns around neglect. Played down everything Axel did.
Mum and Dad work full time.

Axel came with his mother to the session but came to speak to me on his own. Today's session was to gain information regarding Axel's recent assault on a peer.

Axel stated that in regards to the following risk areas he had not experienced any form of harm:

Sexual Assault

Domestic Violence

Deliberate Self Harm

Suicidal Ideation.

Axel stated he feels he has ADD as his attention is bad but doesn't think he has autism this is due to him checking his symptoms online [DPA] Axel explained that he doesn't like Dion because he's his brother but he would never hurt him. Axel stated that he is different from his peers but could not elaborate why.

I asked Axel about his demographic history. He stated that his mum and Dad are from Rwanda and they moved to Cardiff where he and Dion were born. Axel stated that when he was 7 they moved from Cardiff to Southport.

In regards to the incident were Alex took a knife and a hocky stick into school Axel reported the following:

Axel stated that he had thought of this on Saturday night and ordered a taxi the following day. When the taxi arrived monday morning he noticed his actual school taxi and the one he had rang. He had gotten into the latter. When Axel arrived at the range high school he did not pay the taxi driver. Axel stated he through his bag over the fence but struggled to climb over it. Axel stated that he walk though reception and walked around the school grounds for a bit after collecting his bag. Axel states he bumped into Dion and his support worker who them proceeded to follow Axel. Axel states that he attempted to go into assembly to look for [DPA] he didnt get into the room so began to walk away. Axel stated that he felt sad that he couldnt find [DPA] and that he wanted to hit him. Axel stated that he would have only

used the knife if the hocky stick didnt hurt him the way Axel had been hurt.

In regards to Axel's mental health the following Mental State exam was recorded:

APPEARANCE: Axel was well groomed, clean and tidy. there was no indication of self neglect.

SPEECH: Axel made some eye contact but this was not inline with his age. He was very structured in his speech and repetitive with his answers.

ATTITUDE: Axel reported wanting revenge foe being bullied by [DPA] He did not report any other inappropriate attitudes or beliefs. he HAS KEEP ASPIRATIONS TO BE A vet when he is older.

MOOD: Axel reported getting frustrated sometime but this didn't really impact his mood.

Insight and Judgment: Axel did have some insight into his actions however he was very linear in his thinking. He felt that [DPA] should suffer the way he did and could not understand how this would retaliate in wider social groups.

Thoughts: Axel stated that he doesn't get worried but has become a bit paranoid since the police were in his house. He thinks they may have placed cameras around. There were no hallucinations or delusions in line with any serious mental health condition. Axel did not report any voices in or outside his head other than his own.

In terms of autism, my professional opinion would be that Axel douse display A-typical behaviours. He did noth display any empathy or warms but he did laugh at my jokes and engaged well in the session. Although his thinking was ridged he was capable of telling me the details of the assult and why he went to do this. there was no mention of other peoples thoughts or feelings.

Axel did not mention any thoughts of terrorism and actually stated that he does not like thinking of Rwanda or back home. He could not explain why he felt like these. He did express thoughts of low self esteem and confidence.

When the police seized computers from the home. Axel had recently been given an impressive gaming computer which he designed the specifications to the cost of £3000. In regards to other neurotypcal children Axel's ages this would be a devastating consequence. Axel had no emotion regarding this being removed.

I spoke to mum and dad afterwards. They are worried regarding the consequences for Axel but stated he was a 'good boy'. Mum and Dad are also feeling paranoid regarding cameras being placed in the home. Mum and dad have no plans to return to Rwanda.

In my professional opinion i feel Axel is lonely and has had to mature quickly for his age and ability. Axel feels that dion can be a burdon and that he talkes up a lot of mum and Dad's time. As Axel is the younger sibling he feels a lot of resentment towards Dion and feels he is push out a lot at home and in school. I do not feel this young man would search for terrorism/ etc online other than for teenage curiosity with intense autistic backing.

Matt opened the meeting and explained the referral then invited professional updates regarding their information.

Paula Murphy, investigating officer advised that Axel has been arrested and bailed with conditions not to contact the victims by any means not to go within 400m of range high school and not to go into Acorns until agreed by multi agency meeting. Axel provided a prepared statement which stated he had no intention to use the knife. He mentioned being bullied within this statement. He was then interviewed and gave a no comment interview apart from responding to the suggestion he had researched violent acts on the internet which he denied. There were some concerns within the interview where he would laugh at inappropriate times and there was not really any challenge from his mother who was present as appropriate adult. The house has been searched and all electronic devices seized and sent for analysis this could take up to 3 months. In the interim the bail conditions remain and the case is with CPS.

Police have also visited supposed target [DPA] [DPA] who has advised that he knows of Axel but has never had any issues with him. There was comment from [DPA] sister that Axel had

contacted her the day before and called her a retard via Instagram.

Update from Steph Halloran who interviewed Axel whilst in custody to assess his wellbeing and mental health. She advised that Axel disclosed to her that he'd been assaulted by [DPA] [DPA] he said as a result he'd intended to kill him and would have done so if he'd found him. She advised he showed no remorse.

In terms of police dealings with mum and dad mother has generally been very quiet. dad was dismissive when police contacted him to say that Axel needed a parent with him and stated he couldn't get there as he was busy.

Matt queried if a referral had been made for [DPA] who was the actual victim of this attack with the hockey stick. Paula believes so but will check up. Matt also advised to make referral for [DPA] so this was logged. Both children reside in Merseyside.

Update from Range High School
Axel started there in yr. 7 and was initially a very quiet child with no issues being raised. Towards the end of year 8 and this year there has been an escalation in his behaviours he's been challenging and inappropriate in some things he's said to teachers and children alike and when challenged doesn't accept any responsibility. Will basically argue even in the face of evidence to the contrary.

They have had minimal contact with the parents however no major concerns raised dad had raised the issue about [DPA] however there was no evidence of this having taken place.

Regarding Dion, David advised that he [DPA] [DPA] uses a wheelchair in school

The main previous issue in range was from 5/10/19 when Axel had disclosed to Childline that he'd been taking a knife to school and that this had happened on 10 occasions. This was dealt with by Lancs police and referred onto social care and ultimately early help initiated support for the family.

Dad has

expressed concerns to school about whether Axel has SEN.

school aren't aware of any issues between Axel and Dion or there having been any incidents between them.

Steph commented she believes that Axel probably does have ASD. He is due to be assessed next year however the waiting lists for this are significant. During the assessment with her he also mentioned the war in Rwanda and reference to a family member having been injured/ killed during this. He presented as having no rational responses. Axel advised he has researched ASD and ADD on line and believes he has ADD. He has also been referred to Sefton Camhs and is due to be seen in the next week by Scott there. He will also be referred to forensic CAMHS who specialise in assessing risk.

Information from acorns where Axel has been attending since 17th October. He had his admission meeting then and began in class after the half term on 4th November.

Again initially he was very quiet this has then escalated and he's begun to display strange behaviours creating issues with other children and occasionally fixating on staff members. there have also been issues within acorns where he's used the school computers to "research" school shootings etc.

he has disclosed that in his opinion he's been bullied however this has not been evidenced when school have looked into this.

Since starting he's been checked prior to entering school and particular lessons to metal detect him to ensure there's no risk to other pupils.

The one main positive experience for Axel during his time at acorns has been when they did a trip to Chester zoo this was for around 4 hours and during this time he was happy and engaging well with other young people.

Update from early help regarding their involvement, .

referred to them following the incident in October and they had difficulties contacting the family and eventually when they did the majority of fathers concern was to support him in getting Axel back into education.

He did advise that they have a significant amount of support from "parenting 2000" in Southport who've advised they are supporting Axel with counselling on a 2 weekly basis. dad is also due to engage with a parenting course and work on building resilience in families and its reported the family have funded some of this counselling themselves.

Anna and Julie provided an update from their visit yesterday. the family engaged with the visit however it appeared that Axel was quite a force in the household, appearing to dominate discussion and at times shout down his parents who did not appear keen to challenge his opinions. This will require further exploration and visits to speak to parents separate from Axel and also speak to Dion by himself.

contrary to his interview and discussion with Steph Axel told Anna and Julie that he had taken the knife to school for protection. Again in their opinion he presented with traits of ASD to a high level.

Parents did say that they do struggle at times with boundaries. Overall it appears that Axel's parents potentially don't understand his additional needs and how to best parent him. There were no concerns regarding neglect or any sense that parents posed a risk to Axel and there have been no reports of risk from Axel to Dion. Carmen Thompson from Prevent identified that she will be completing an assessment regarding Axel and considering if a referral to channel programme would be appropriate for him.

Concerns summarised and discussion held regarding risk of significant harm. It was agreed that there is a risk of re-offending from Axel however at this point based on the interactions so far there is no evidence that the children are presently at risk of significant harm. There are positives to consider regarding the parents engagement so far and willingness to work with the LA in these early stages as well as their reported attempts to gain support for Axel through parenting 2000.

It was acknowledged that there is a possibility that through the highlighted actions and assessments risks may escalate but at this time tot he plan is to proceed with assessment work

and reconvene when we have more professional knowledge of the family.

Telephone conversation with Alphonse (father).

We discussed Axel's current presentation. His father informed me that Axel was okay in general but that he had been experiencing a lot of 'nervousness' going out. This means he struggles to go to the shop unless accompanied by a parent. This has been an ongoing issue. It is not new and even when he was at school, he struggled to cope unless his friends were with him. Alphonse described Axel's nervous behaviour as rubbing his hands uncontrollably, shaking and getting easily upset or angry. This is also exacerbated by Axel's poor sleep as he is often awake for long periods struggling to get to sleep due to feeling mentally alert and bored.

Alphonse described Axel as requiring a lot of mental stimulation but not very energetic. In relation to mood Alphonse described Axel as someone who may get frustrated if something is said to him that he perceives as offensive or judging. Axel was described as getting into an argument easily if he disagreed with something and that he will stick to his view. We discussed how axel could become quite rigid in his views. Alphonse agreed and we discussed how this might be a characteristic of ASC.

Alphonse said that a referral has been made to the ASC Pathway but as yet they have not had an assessment. Alphonse said he would contcat the ASC Pathway to find out some more information.

Axel attends Acorn school but Axel has told his father that he would prefer to return to mainstream. Alphonse acknowledged this would be difficult due to the incident where another pupil was injured by Axel. Alphonse said Axel is not doing any schoolwork at home and Axel has said that he will do school work at school but not at home. Alphonse is in regular contact with the school and there is a Skype meeting on Tuesday.

Axel has stated that he would like to consider medication for the nervousness. However Alphonse said that he has concerns about side effects. I stated that I would discuss the medication with the MDT tomorrow but that talking therapy is the primary intervention indicated for anxiety. I stated that Axel would need to consider participating in some sessions that focused on education around anxiety and finding ways of learning how to manage and cope with different situations whether he was prescribed medication or not. Alphonse said he was in agreement that talking therapy should be considered first.

I agreed to contact Axel tomorrow at 12pm to introduce myself and to establish some goals he would like to work towards in relation to the nervousness he is reporting. Alphonse also provided his email DPA for future correspondence. I explained that the email contact was for arranging appointments and sharing information sheets only and should not be used for crisis or discussing clinical matters as these should be undertaken by telephone. I reiterated how the family could contact CAMHS either by the main service telephone number or via the crisis line. Alphonse informed me at the moment there were no problems regarding Axel's mental state or mood but he had the numbers if required.

I spoke with Axel as he father said he was in a good mood this morning and that he was aware that i would be calling. Axel said that he hadn't been experiencing much anxiety. I asked him how he had been

able to achieve this. Axel said he wasn't sure. I encouraged Axel to consider what had made the difference for him. I asked him about the information sheets and he confirmed he had not read them. I encouraged him to read them so that we could consider them together. I also asked Axel if he would be able to chart or make a note of some of his worry and to rate it in different situations. Axel said that he was unlikely to do this. I asked how we might go about understanding the anxiety and its influence. Axel said he wasn't sure. I suggested that we try to examine the anxiety together in our telephone conversations. Axel agreed to this. Axel said that he often had worry around but he wasn't sure what it was. it was different things.

I agreed to confirm the date and time and time of our next appointment with his father. I subsequently sent an email to Alphonse offering Friday 12th June 1pm. I will also send some additional information relating to anxiety and its management for Alphonse to read and share with Axel.

Telephone call to family for ongoing anxiety intervention. I spoke with Alphonse who informed me that Axel was in bed. He agreed to try to wake Axel but Axel declined to speak with me. Axel did not give an explanation.

I spoke with Alphonse about how we can overcome the difficulties in engagement as Axel is not keen on speaking with me. Alphonse stated that he thinks it might better if we consider a face to face appointment. I agreed to offer Axel another appointment on Monday 15 June at 4.45pm as it is in the afternoon and hopefully Axel will be awake and out of bed.

I encouraged Alphonse to speak with Axel about the appointments and to talk about what Axel would like to gain from them. Alphonse said he had read the anxiety management materials I had sent and these had been useful. I suggested that Alphonse try and speak with Axel about the information sheets and to consider how they each might show bias in different situations and how noticing these bias might influence the way they experience each other and the situation.

Telephone call to Axel and parent as planned for partnership appointment to address anxiety. We had agreed that I would call late in the day as it may be a better opportunity to speak with Axel, as he has been in bed sleeping a lot through the day.

I spoke with Alphonse who said he had not seen or spoken to Axel as he had been in bed. I asked Alphonse if they had spoken about my previous calls and the information I had sent. Alphonse informed me that he and Axel had not spoken about my contacts as Axel did not want to talk with him about it.

Alphonse tried to wake Axel and passed him the phone. The phone call ended. I called back and Alphonse informed me that Axel had pressed the button to end the call rather than speak with me.

I spoke at length with Alphonse about how it would not be appropriate to continue to persist in offering appointments to Axel that he did not want. Alphonse requested an appointment in September as it was likely that when Axel was asked to go back to school he would become distressed. I stated that I had offered anxiety management to Axel that would also address anticipatory anxiety and what preparations could be made to support Axel during any times of transition but Axel was not showing any willingness or readiness. Alphonse stated that he worried about getting back into CAMHS if Axel was discharged. I stated that Axel would be re-allocated a case manager if re-referred within 3 months.

I stated that I would discuss with the MDT as I had reservations about a young person being open to CAMHS who was declining any treatment or intervention. I stated that I had offered both telephone and online consultation to Axel but he was declining. Alphonse suggested I offer a face to face. I agreed to offer a face to face appointment on 2 July 3pm at Burlington House (conditional on it being approved by the MDT). Alphonse asked if it could be offered in August and when I clarified why he wanted August he said it was to try to get it as close to September as possible.

I reiterated that I would offer 2 July 3pm at Burlington House (subject to approval by the MDT). I stated that all requests for face to face contacts needed to be considered due to the restrictions in relation to COVID-19. I agreed to confirm face to face appointment by email. Alphonse was in agreement and stated that Axel had been receiving therapy from Claudia at Parenting 2000 but this was due to end. Prior to this Alphonse stated he had been paying for therapy privately which is also why he was wanting to remain involved with CAMHS.

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Clinical Notes::

Axel attended with his father Alphonse. They were late arriving as Alphonse had taken Axel to Southport Hub instead of Burlington House. Alphonse had informed me that he could be at Burlington at 3.30pm but they arrived at 4pm. I agreed to see them and we completed an hour session. Alphonse remained with Axel throughout the meeting although we agreed that it may be useful for Axel to be seen alone for part of the meeting.

Axel stated that nerves was his main problem and that he had experienced anxiety since yr5. It has been worse in Yr7 particularly in relation to social situations and eating in social situations. These difficulties occur mostly in school although also at home sometimes. We discussed how he was able to find ways of managing at home that meant he did not encounter situations that made him anxious. We discussed how this may be part of a pattern of avoidance that temporarily removes the anxiety but disables him from tolerating it in the future. Axel described experiencing thoughts that he was being judged by others when in school. Alphonse stated that he believed Axel had encountered a lot of bullying and difficulties in relationships in school which had possibly made the nerves worse for Axel. Axel denied this and stated that his father was wrong. Axel frequently rejected his fathers ideas about what was contributing to the

nervousness and said that what he was saying was stupid. His father also commented on the possibility of Axel having ASC. Axel stated that he did not think he had autism and said that he could normally tell if someone had ASC. I shared that it was often difficult for professionals to determine so I was curious about he was able to know who had ASC. He said he didn't know. I also asked Axel if he had done any reading or research on ASC to help him understand what it was and he said he had not.

I talked about 'mind reading' and bias as possible factors in generating worry. Axel stated that he had received 20 sessions from a psychologist. His father clarified that it was a counsellor and I confirmed that it was through Parenting 2000. Alphonse stated that Axel was now wanting medication. I stated that medication was not the first line treatment and that talking therapy was indicated. Axel stated that he felt that people didn't think the anxiety was serious. I responded by saying that the purpose in our conversation was to talk about the anxiety and that it was one of the most prevalent problems children and adults experienced. I spoke with Axel about the need to be motivated and active in tackling the anxiety through talking and behavioural experiments. I used the imagery of a football player, encouraging Axel to think about how much training they undertake in order to perform on the pitch under stress. I suggested that it would be difficult for someone to play in a football team if they had never played before and hadn't spent any time preparing or learning. I linked this to anxiety management and the requirement for persistence and perseverance in overcoming the obstacles.

I recommended Axel revisit the educational material about anxiety I had sent him as he had not read any of it. I shared some diagrams about the effects of anxiety on the brain and arousal. I asked Axel was had been useful to him in the meeting and he said he wasn't sure. His father said it might be helpful if Axel had some time alone in future meetings as this may help Axel to talk more with him being present.

Outcome:

I agreed to meet with Axel face to face again on 9th July 3pm at Burlington House. His father agreed to bring him to the meeting and accompany him for part of the session. I have agreed to continue to explore anxiety and its management with Axel.

I also informed Axel that I have a meeting arranged with his YOT worker John Fitzpatrick and the West Lancs CAMHS Practitioner assigned to YOT on 9th July.
