Child(ren)/Young Person's thoughts and feelings	Axel expressed his views clearly during the meeting and feels that he is happy for children and Family Well-being service to close stating <b>that he wanted the case to close saying there is no point keeping it open as they haven't done anything.</b>
Parent/Carer's thoughts and feelings	Alphonse requested for CFW to remain open whilst Axel is going through the transition process to Presfield sharing that Axel still at times says he doesn't want to go to school and that's where they face challenges. Alphonse did then despite agreeing with agency's that all needs are met say that he still felt that CFW needed to be involved, he stated this was for if in the future Axels needs are not met, Axel was not in agreement with him and said " <b>he felt the plan should close</b> ". Alphonse was reminded that CFW are a time limited service that works at level 3 on the continuum of needs and that currently there are no unmet needs in the family.
<b>Summary of the progress your family has made, what difference has this made to your child(ren) and what action is now needed over the next 4-6 weeks?</b>	All actions in the plan have been met and the TAF members have reported that there has been significant improvements for Axel, He has been offered a place at Prestfield SEN school which he will start in the Summer term.  There has been significant improvement in the family and it has been evidenced through the RADAR that the family now feel in a much better place. It is likely that due to the family having a significant amount of support from services that Alphonse is worried about doing this alone now. There will be challenges in the home because Alphonse and Axels relationship is strained at times however the family do now need to put the skills in place that they have learnt and also need to have some time to manage this without intensive support. Education and health support will still be in place but parenting support will now fall to the family.  <b>Axel will continue to work with School and CAMHS to ensure that his education and health needs are met and it was agreed in the meeting that this could be done through the EHCP.</b>
