Following previous referral father called MASH after receiving a letter.

Previous school referral

Axel was seen by a CAMHS practitioner in January 2023. Elizabeth Walker and Sharon Rowlands from Lancashire SEN are in close contact with the school . Parents communicate with school via email and they come out of the front door to speak on the doorstep when we visit.

Axel was last seen by school staff on 25th May 2022. He is not able to engage with school. School staff have attempted to engage with Axel but he is too anxious to see any of us at school or at home. His Dad Alphonse commented that parents will 'pay the price' if staff go into the home and we have been unable to see him. Sefton Council's school attendance team completed a home visit on 20th March 2023. Here is the feedback :- Angela Maguire has visited and met mum who it was reported aired her annoyance and confusion over our involvement. On explaining it was a welfare visit, Angela was greeted with a complaint from mum who it was said saw no reason for the visit and she flatly refused for Angela to see Axel. Discussion was brief given Angela's case information knowledge, and she could only accept mum's complaint informing her that she will pass it on. With this, as we can now evidence that we have exhausted everything to make contact and take sight of Axel, can you now contact Lancashire Police and request a welfare visit to the home. Please share that the young person has not been seen for the time you have recorded. Secondly can you also share again your concerns with Lancashire CME & SEN team. SEN ultimately have the responsibility to address the concerns as part of his plan.

For someone to ensure on the safety and welfare of Axel Rudakubana . For support for Axel as he is currently not attending his college placement and for him to get the support he needs so that he is no longer socially isolated and so unwell with his mental health that he can not see staff from school. I am ticking the box 'no' to the following question 'is the child currently missing' - however I DO NOT KNOW as we have been unable to see him . Parents tell us he is in the house.

I have referred into Lancashire CME team who tell me Axel is not in their remit. I have asked Lancashire police to complete a welfare check to see Axel - collar number 11097 told me that Axel does not meet threshold for a welfare visit. Elizabeth Walker and Sharon Rowland at Lancashire SEN team have been alerted of the situation and Sharon suggested that if we have safeguarding concerns we should report to social care. She has also spoken with the 'duty team'.

| Additional information gathered to inform contact outcome. | <p>JF 3rd April</p> <p>Further information from father</p> <p>Father called CSC requesting support with Axel. Axel is in 6th form and rarely attending. In the last few weeks however he has agreed to go in one hour at a time, but this is only now and again. Father said he has called MASH after receiving the letter as he would like more support with Axel. He said last time CFW were involved things improved. He said Sharon was the worker; she helped a lot, but father would accept support from any of the workers. Father feels let down by school, he feels they are not patient enough with Axel. Father said when the case last closed to CFW, things got worse. Father said Axel responded well to their support, he said they have a way to access him. Father is concerned as Axel is not getting enough of an education. I advised that I would make a referral to CFW to address Axel's needs. Advised someone would be in touch soon.</p> <p>From CSC history</p> <p>Known since 2019.</p> <p>2 C&Fs 2020 and 2021:</p> <p>2020 - <i>Axel being arrested on suspicion of Section 47 assault, possession of a bladed article on a school premises and possession of an offensive weapon .</i></p> <p>2021 - <i>This assessment was completed due to father requesting support with Axel's additional needs. Axel has a diagnosis of ASD and he can present with challenging behaviour within both the home and school environments.</i></p> <p>CIN Feb-Mar 2020.</p> <p>From case summary on LCS:</p> <p><i>Axel wishes to be in school however education feel that he is an unassessed risk currently. Axel has been out of education since 2019 although is receiving work which is being sent home. Axel has since stated that he regrets what's happened. Axel feels that he has ODD and ASD as he has been researching it online.</i></p> <p>There have been 4 EH episodes. Looking at 'forms' on EHM, much CFW intervention has been completed.</p> |

| Reason for Action Taken | <p>Case recommended to be stepped down to CFW. Father has contacted MASH after receiving a letter following the last referral. Axel is likely to continue to have poor mental health if left unaddressed, and not achieve academically, which will impact on his future choices. As a result the following support plan is proposed.</p> <p>CON - 3. Consent - yes. Needs/intervention - Axel has significant mental health issues, impacting on him accessing education. He suffers with anxiety which has led to non school/college attendance/low attainment/social isolation. Intervention could address this by one to one work with Axel, attempting to engage him in positive activities with others, and increase his college attendance. Risks - none known.</p> |
| Managers Comments | <p>MO 04/04/2023 14:11 CH Father has contacted MASH following letter received from MASH and is seeking support in relation to Axel's difficulties with his MH. This case sits at Level 3 (FIS) on Lancashire's Continuum of Need, with the support needs being met through a referral to CFWS so that a multi-agency co-ordinated response can occur. Plan of support is identified within assessment and consent recorded and obtained from father for support from FIS. Should there be any safeguarding concerns or additional support needs identified, the professionals can explore these and re-refer to CSC for further consideration as per step across process and agreement from TM.</p> |
