Good morning,

We have a child on our roll, Axel Rudakubana DOB 07/08/2006. He was permanently excluded from yourselves in October, after he disclosed to Childline that he had been bringing a knife into school with the intention of using it on another pupil.

We have serious safeguarding concerns with regard to Axel. He is fixating on another student in his class and is saying that he is bossing him around and bullying him. Staff are being vigilant, but have seen no evidence of this. Dad has contacted school to raise his concerns that Axel is being targeted "like the other boy in the other school!"

During his ICT lesson Axel was searching school shootings in America. Dad was informed of this, but then rang back and said it was untrue.

I would be extremely grateful if you could supply any further information about the final incident or the events leading up to it. We haven't received the Headteachers report or any other supporting documentation to help us. I have attached the only information we were given.
