Father, Alphonsa Rudakubana, requests a needs and carers assessment for both children. Father states there are no safeguarding concerns, however, he and his wife are struggling to look after the children and require financial assistance from children's social care.

Father requests these assessments in the hope a financial support package will be awarded for respite care and personal assistant provisions for both children.

Father states Axel is [DPA] Autistic and struggles with social communication / social interactions and so requires a personal assistant for 1:1 support / activities outside of the family home.

Father initially requested LCSC financial support him and his wife to carry out their parenting roles as father has had to give up his employment role to care for the children due to their additional needs. Father also requested LCSC finance a family holiday as "they had not had one for a while due to low income".

Father confirmed being in receipt of DLA and carers allowance for both children.

Father was advised that LCSC would not be in a position to financially support him to carry out his parenting role as this is what the DLA and Carers allowance is for. Father was advised that LCSC would not be in a position to finance a family holiday either.

Father was advised of the support available to the family via the Family Intensive Support Team, Lancashire SEND Offer and Lancashire Breaktime Services, however remains strongly of the view that a needs and carers assessment is required at this point.
