It was such a shame that Axel was unable to access school today after firstly agreeing to this, please keep trying. I have had to pass this on to the school's safeguarding officer as we have been unable to see Axel for quite a while now and he has been unwilling to see a member of staff when we call out to the home. I don't want to cause any conflict at home by insisting on Axel agreeing to see me or any member of staff when we call out to do a home visit. However, due to previous conversations you are aware that we have a duty of care and responsibility to try to see him at home when he is refusing to attend. I imagine this will now be passed on to attendance and welfare as a concern.

In the meantime, please let us know if there is anything we can try to do to facilitate Axel accessing school and keep trying each day for his attendance. If he is refusing, can you let the school office know as we need to organise staffing for when he is here. Thank you for your continued support.

Following a call with Emma Lambert at Lancashire LEA the other day I have now spoken with Matthew Hall a 'Children's Champion' also with Lancashire LEA. Emma had asked him to contact me. I know one of you has a review tomorrow at 1.30 for Axel as it is on the calendar. I have expressed our concerns again about the vulnerability of Axel and his school attendance of 7.3% with unauthorised absences of 81.8%.

I have shared concerns that he has not been seen by staff despite our best efforts since 25th May . I have been clear that we have tried everything possible to engage him but have not been able to even complete a welfare home visit. He suggested we send police! I explained this is not appropriate and that we do not have specific safeguarding concerns which warrant a social care referral hence the early help one for support.

The upshot is that he will now check their system to see where Gayle Lavelle (SEN) is up to . I have also given him Samantha Steed's name at CAMHS .

I explained Sefton's FDR system including home visits and Matthew informed me Lancashire do not do this. He said if Axel was more local he would pop out but he lives 90 minutes away and it is not a good use of his time.

Hayley I shared your view that year 12 may not be a viable option for him as we cannot meet need nor engage Axel to attend.

Karen Gray has completed the early help and put that in today.

Dear Iain,

I am sending you this email to inform you of the situation with student Axel Rudakubana who is currently on roll within our Sixth Form. We provided him with a place in Sixth Form despite him being a year 11 student. We did this in the hope it would enable him, with a long transition, to be able to join the Sixth Form proper from Sept 2022. This has not been the case and we are not meeting need. We are consequently withdrawing the placement offer for Sept.

On Thursday 7th July we held Axel's annual review meeting at Presfield. It was attended by myself, Hayley Dawson, our Headteacher, Mr Fay and also Axel's Father Alphonse who attended the meeting online. Disappointedly, nobody from Lancashire was able to attend the meeting in person or online, even after several invites and despite the placement being at serious risk of breaking down.

During the meeting it was discussed that due to Axel's unwillingness to attend our setting or to engage with us on any level meant we were not meeting need and that his placement with us will end this summer and from 1st September 2022 there will not be a place within our Sixth Form provision for Axel.

It is clear that Axel is struggling with his mental health and high levels of anxiety which are impacting on his ability to be able to leave the family home. CAMHS (Samantha Steed - Caseworker) involvement is still in place however, Axel is unable to attend regularly and therefore is not benefitting from the supportive service they can provide.

Due to Axel's mental health being in such a counterproductive place this now clearly needs to be his primary need in order to improve his quality of life and therefore his ASC has become secondary to this. As we are a specialist ASC setting it is now a concern for us that we are unable to support Axel on any level within our setting remit and due to us being an oversubscribed provision it can now be seen that Axel is ultimately 'place blocking' and preventing us from being able to support another student who wants to and is able to engage and benefit from the support we offer at Presfield. It is not a sufficient use of public funding to draw funding for a child who never attends the school especially when that place can be utilised by another student. I am sure you are aware of the Nolan Principles, in particular "Integrity", leaders should not act or take decisions in order to gain financial benefits. If we were to continue with the placement for Axel we would be simply gaining financial benefits. This is incompatible with the use of public resources.



Healthy School

Axel's attendance figures are devastatingly low, since he came on roll with us at Easter 2022 he now has an attendance figure of 7% with an unauthorised attendance figure of over 80%. Axel has not been seen by ourselves in person since 25th May 2022. We have attempted to engage with Axel on many different occasions and by many different methods such as 1-1 meetings with a member of his form class staff, home visits by form class and Sixth Form staff, Safeguarding Leads and most recently our Family Support Worker in order to help the family complete an Early Help Referral. All of which have proved unsuccessful with Axel refusing to even show his face at the top of the stairs or from a window. An inordinate amount of time has been spent by our staff trying to visit and engage with Axel. This has been detrimental to our other students as it has removed staff from supporting them. Axel remaining at the school is incompatible with the efficient education of other children in the school.

Subsequent to this we have also contacted Lancashire and spoken to Emma Lambert from the Lancashire LEA team about our concerns around Axel's attendance. Following on from this our Lead DSL has also spoken to Matthew Hall a 'Children's Champion' on Wednesday 6th July 2022 who was unable to offer us any further support but suggested that the possible next step would be Police involvement to which we feel would not be effective for Axel or his family. In fact this is likely to create more anxiety for Axel. We have not heard anything back from Gayle Lavelle (SEN) who Matthew said he would pass our concerns and requests for support on to.

In order to try and engage Axel we have made numerous changes to his timetable, daily hours, work spaces, eating arrangements for lunch, safe spaces to access whilst at Presfield and time provided to develop relationships with staff with whom he would be working. None of these things unfortunately have resulted in Axel engaging with us and we are now in the situation of letting you know that we will no longer be able to meet Axel's needs from September 2022 and his placement at Presfield will no longer be open to him.

As you are aware in accordance with the SEN Code of Practice (section 9: 79) the Local Authority must name the school of the parent's preference unless:

- it is unsuitable to the child's age, ability, aptitude or special educational needs. This is the case as Axel's need is clearly mental health
- the placement would be incompatible with the efficient education of other children in the school. This is the case as time is taken away from supporting other students to travel and engage with Axel. Axel is also blocking a place for another student who may benefit from the support the school offers.
- the placement would be incompatible with the efficient use of public resources. This is the case because we would be drawing funding for a student who we do not see.

I hope everybody understands that Axel has autism and extreme anxiety that causes him to avoid going out of the house in general.

Today was the first day of the school year and a taxi was sent home to collect him. Axel wasn't ready to go to school today but to be fair to him, I didn't prepare him yesterday that the school was starting today. My apologies.

I spoke to Axel during the summer holidays and we talked again this morning. He repeated to me that his problem is not disliking school but when he steps outside in public he secretes excessive saliva and it happened two days ago when we went together in the car to pick up his brother from the train station even though he didn't leave the car. I told him that on 7th July 2022, I referred him to Presfield's Language Therapist and the OT/Counsellor and asked him if it was okay for them to come and see him at home. Axel replied that he would let them see him at home.

I would like to ask for patience and understanding of Axel's condition to appreciate that rehabilitating him back in the public space including the school will be a slow process and will require a lot of patience from Presfield and that his place there be secure in order to give him a chance to a formal education, especially now we are in September and Community colleges have already started this academic year. Please let us not forget the reason that we sought him a place in special education instead of the mainstream education.

Thank you for your email and I too hope you and Axel had a good summer.

As stated in our letter dated 14/7/22 I do not feel we are meeting Axel's needs and consequently withdrew his placement. This decision was not made in haste and we did discuss this in the review meeting held on July 7th 2022. We have tried many different strategies to try and engage with Axel to no avail.

We are a school who caters for students with a diagnosis of Autism and have an awareness of how anxiety can impact students. I am pleased to hear he does not dislike school and understand how the secretion of excess saliva can be upsetting for him. However, as an oversubscribed school his inability to leave his house and attend school is blocking a place for another student who may benefit from the education offer we have.

It is our belief that his mental health and wellbeing are his primary need and this is what he requires support with. We do not have the specialisms to support Axel with his mental health. We have tried to engage with Axel at home without any success and I am not confident that asking our OT and Speech and Language therapist to attend your house will be a success. I appreciate he has assured you he will speak with staff if they come to him. Unfortunately our past experience shows a different picture and from your comments he does not seem to have improved his mental well being.

We have a duty to try and get the best care for Axel and do not believe that is with us. If he was to remain on our roll he would not be a priority in Lancashire and consequently may not get the support he so clearly requires. By not being on our roll the authority will have a duty to find a setting and package of support best suited for his needs.

As a staff team we display great patience and understanding and an awareness of the time rehabilitation into education can take. Unfortunately we have not seen any signs that this has had any impact. As stated in Ms Dawsons letter we believe:-

- Presfield is unsuitable to the child's age, ability, aptitude or special educational needs. This is the case as Axel's need is clearly mental health.
- His placement would be incompatible with the efficient education of other children in the school. This is the case as time is taken away from supporting other students while staff travel to try and engage with Axel. Axel is also blocking a place for another student who may benefit from the support the school offers.
- the placement would be incompatible with the efficient use of public resources. This is the case because we would be drawing funding for a student who we do not see. This is against the Nolan Principles of public life.


I hope axel receives the support he clearly requires
