29.7.2024

4.50pm I was informed by TAP Rachel Campbell that there was an emergency referral for GU. No referral paperwork was provided, and I was invited to discuss this in her / psychology office in the therapies corridor where FCAMHS Manager Ian Moggridge had already spoken to her and Rea Cardwell about the lad.

5pm. Ian Moggridge arrived in RC TAP' s office and briefed me on the case; showed me the news articles on SKY and BBC and spoke to me re AR' s FCAMHS involvement. Ian advised that he had a discussion with the duty AMHP who had initially approached AR' s local CAMHS Unit Ancora House for a psychiatrist to join them for a section 12 assessment, however had been advised that due to the forensic involvement they would recommend that I be approached for this. The AMHP had then contacted Ian Moggridge and discussed the case with him.

5.15pm Ian and I had a phone call with the AMHP Steven Roper to find out more about the situation and AR' s mental state. We were advised that AR was at the police station and a discussion had already been done with Ashworth HSU from where a psychiatrist Dr Melanie Higgins was already on her way to the police station for this MHA assessment. We were also advised that it had already been agreed that should AR be found detainable under the MHA, he would be admitted to Ashworth hospital and not GU (despite him being 9 days short of his 18th birthday) owing to the seriousness of the alleged offence and him not being too far from turning 18. We were not advised as to who had been involved in this agreement. Ian then went to speak with Rachel Green to update her.

5.30pm Rachel Campbell and I set off for the police station for this assessment, prior to which Dr AP CT3 doctor GU requested that he be allowed to join us at the police station as he was extremely keen to observe the MHA process. I explained to him that it was likely that there would be numerous professionals involved already but perhaps he could be in the periphery, for his learning but it may not be possible for him to directly observe the interview, something which we would need to review at the police station as it was a evolving sensitive situation. He agreed and would travel separately to the police station in his own vehicle as he needed to go home first. Enroute, I switched on my mobile phone (was switched off at GU) to find a text message and missed call from the Clinical Director Ancora House Dr Anjan Mandara asking me to contact her. Enroute, I spoke with her who confirmed that she wanted to alert me to this incident and to anticipate a call from the AMHP whom she had suggested that I be approached due to the needed forensic expertise and GU being the local AMSU for AR. On my request she explained that AR was not known to their service and that I should contact the Alder Hay CAMHS Crises Team to access AR' s psychiatric information. She provided me with their phone number which I called from the car while we were just arriving at the police station. The Alder Hay CAMHS Crises Team oncall consultant Dr Sally Al-Bachari said that AR had already been discharged from their Community CAMHS service

some months ago. AR had a diagnosis of autism, anxiety and depression. He had previously been on sertraline, melatonin and propranolol which he had stopped saying that it had not benefitted him. AR had also not been leaving his house for a prolonged period possibly due to anxiety. He had been given psychotherapy by their service. They did not have any current professional contact with AR. After the brief phone call, we entered the police station. We were met by the police, liaison diversion team, Ashworth psychiatrist Melanie Higgins. After a brief conversation on the above information, we proceeded to assess AR in the police cells. It was the AMHP, Melanie Higgins and I accompanied by the custody police officer. Rachel stayed back in the liaison office while AP spoke to the parents on our request as we needed to expediate access to his recently observed behaviours prior to the incident.

It was a small cell, with AR lying on the bed, covered with duvet, drawn up to his nose which he did not move, and did not engage in the assessment despite our numerous prompts after we introduced ourselves. We returned to the liaison office, and then returned to see him again twice after this with much similar lack of engagement from him. He did not accept offer of a glass of water when this was offered to him. When the officer pulled the duvet away from him, AR pulled up his T Shirt to cover his face up to his nose. His eyes remained alert and moved around to scan the room and us.

We had another discussion in the liaison office where upon my request custody sergeant tried to show us the video of AR getting arrested as we had been told that we had made a statement to the effect that he "can't breathe". The video could not be immediately located.

The AMHP Mr Roper then typed the report on the liaison laptop which was dictated by Dr Higgins and the information was added on to by myself verbally, before I edited the typed report on the laptop and showed it to Dr Higgins for her editing before the AMHP finalised it and this was sent to the custody sergeant. We had advised the police and the Liaison team that should AR's mental health presentation change, they should let us know and we would be happy to re-assess AR.

Around 9pm or so Dr AP and I left the police station. RC had already left a little while ago. On the way back from the station I emailed GMMH CAMHS professionals and senior ops with the outcome that we did not place AR on the MHA.

30.07.2024

Contact with the police station to find out if there had been any change to AR's mental health presentation overnight. I was advised that there had not been. He had eaten a sandwich the previous late night, spoken to the duty social worker for a few minutes and the duty solicitor around 3am.

30.07.2024

2pm Contact from GU NHSE Taz Yakub who wanted to know about the MHA assessment and if AR needed an admission. I spoke with her explaining our police station contact and that an admission on a civil section was not indicated, however we had advised the police and the Liaison team that should AR's mental health presentation change, they should let us know and we would be happy to re-assess AR. Taz said her NHSE counterpart from Ashworth was also wondering if AR needed to be admitted and that she would update them.

3.15pm I contacted the Youth Custody Service (YCS) to make them aware of our contact with AR and his mental health condition to aid their decision making in his placement via the Court.

4pm AMSN Weekly referral meeting – I mentioned about the case and our assessment at the police station. This was attended by Taz Yakub NHSE GU.

6.30pm I emailed Wetherby YOI Clinical Lead alerting him of AR and suggesting a Teams meeting for the next day to share him with him the context and information as it was more than likely that AR would be remanded to custody with them, as it was the local HMYOI.

7.15pm I received a reply for Wetherby Clinical Lead suggesting a time of 11.30am for 31.7.2024 for a Teams meeting.

31.7.2024

11.30am Teams meeting held with Wetherby Clinical Lead and discussion on my contact with AR at the police

station, liaison with professionals so far and suggesting that they keep an eye on his mental state and risks with a view that there might be a need for ongoing mental health assessment and a potential need for an admission assessment, in which case they should alert us (given that he was still below 18) and we would further alert Ashworth. I offered to join their morning handover meeting over Teams to speak with their MDT / consultants if that would be helpful and also if they felt that AR needed to be seen by us, then to let us know. I was advised that should they feel a need for our involvement, they would let us know.

31.7.2024

10.15am Teams Meeting with YCS and briefed them about AR and his presentation to aid their decision making in deciding his placement via the Court.

1.30pm I made a Teams call to Amanda Jayne Brown Head of Ops to update her on AR.

3pm Telephone contact from Police station Custody Liaison Nurse who advised that AR's blood sugar levels had dropped quite low, he had been declining to eat and this was causing a significant worry. They wondered if AR had the capacity for food refusal and if he needed to be moved to the acute hospital for IV fluids. I suggested some approaches that we would use if a patient did the similar behaviour on our ward. I also suggested that they contact custody physical health liaison nurse and on call GP. Later that night, I was informed that my suggested approach had worked, and AR had eaten a pizza now. AR was interviewed by the police every day.

4pm I contacted AMSN Clinical Lead Dr John O' Brien whom I updated on my contact with AR, liaison with professionals as above incl HMYOI Wetherby thereafter.

01.08.2024

10am AR was produced at Liverpool Youth Court followed by the Crown Court same late morning during which his name was released to the public by the Judge as that was considered to be in the public interest, given the ongoing riots situation.

1.30pm I contacted Wetherby YOI Clinical Lead to alert him that AR was likely to be remanded into their care that afternoon.

4pm I wrote in details to Wetherby YOI Clinical Lead and copied it to Wetherby Consultant Psychiatrists and Clinical Nurse Specialist about our contact with AR, police station assessment, liaison so far and that we would be willing to assist with participating in their meetings over Teams / in person.

02.08.2024

5pm I was informed by Wetherby Clinical Lead that they had attempted to interview AR briefly through the door (semi-transparent door) but he did not engage. They would try again later.

No further contact received from Wetherby.

27.09.2024

Met with DC Dave Williams Merseyside police for a police interview at GU in relation to contact with AR at the police station on 29.7.2024. This interview was asked for urgently by the Merseyside police as they needed to submit this information to the Liverpool Crown Court. DC Williams was keen to interview me asap as he said it was needed for the Court deadlines. This meeting was held at the MPL in the Gardener Unit. I told DC Williams that I had assessed AR on the evening of 29.7.2024 at the police station on the request of duty AMHP to ascertain if he needed to be placed on a MHA section. I explained that AR had previously had involvement with FCAMHS NW by way of consultation and following the incident on 29.7.2024 I had been requested by Ian Moggridge FCAMHS Manager to see AR, and I had been accompanied by Rachel Campbell TAP and also we were joined by Dr Aron Pasricha CT doctor. AR had not engaged in the assessment despite a number of attempts. We had not placed him on MHA section. The police already had accessed the MHA section assessment from the Custody Sergeant and AMHP. The officer said that I may need to attend the Court in January 2025.
