Details: Axel RUDAKUBUNA, 16 - Skelmersdale (Banks)

5ft6 black male, very slim build with an afro haircut. Axel has a scar on his forehead from an injury when younger. Axel was last seen wearing blue jeans and black Adidas trainers.

Axel is autistic and has ADHD. His needs are described as completed, as such he has left mainstream education and has been waiting to start in a special needs school, Pressfield. Axel was meant to meet his new teachers and have a tour of the school today, he has gone missing before this meeting. Axel previously attended Acorns and Range High School in Formby.

Axel is currently taking sertraline to help with his mental health.

Axel has been described as not liking crowded places. He does have a mobile phone but this is switched off and going straight through to VM. A message has been left by police.

Axel has been missing previously, although was found at Range High school within an hour.

The range for which Axel has left the house is between 0830 and 1115 on 17.03.22. He has taken a house key with him. There are two council cameras overlooking the home address, these are currently being checked by Ormskirk CCTV for a more specific date.

A small knife has gone missing from the kitchen, parents believes, but can't confirm, Axel has this.

Axel has never threatened or attempted self harm.
