He refused to attend his educational placement in a special needs school in Southport.

He has refused to take his prescribed medication for his autism for the past week and this is having a profound effect on his well being.

He is getting older and stronger. His parents are struggling to cope with him. They are going to contact CAHMS and his GP.

Any help would be greatly assist the family.

Further PSR received due to the family are struggling to cope with their son's behaviour. As well as Axel refusing to taking his prescribed medication, which is having an impact on his emotional well being.

23.5.2022@ 10:38 Phone call to Father, Alphonse [DPA] answer. Message left for a return call.

23.5.2022@ 13:57 Phone call to Father, Alphonse , [DPA] Asked how things were at present with Axel. Alphonse said that they had just come from a meeting with CAMHS , a Psychotherapist and a Psychiatrist who are putting a new plan together. Axel has also said that he will start to take his medication tomorrow and will go to school for a few hours.

Alphonse said that Axel will say this but then when the time comes he will not do it.

Asked what support he feels he requires for Axel. He said that he needs someone to come and speak with him about going to school, explained that this should be school that are doing this. Alphonse said that when they come Axel goes to his room and wont speak to them.

He also said that he wants someone to come and speak with Axel when there is a crisis and the arguing starts.

Asked him if he had been on the Triple P parenting and Riding the Rapids courses that were on the previous plan of support. He has been on the Triple P but the Riding Rapids was cancelled. Advised he needs to speak with CAMHS to ask to be referred again to this. What advice he is given on the courses he needs to put into use within the home with Axel.

Asked what the changes were since the CFWS had closed in March 2022. Axel behaviours and not going to school. Axel refusing his medication which is having an impact . Again explained that this is a health issue and this is why he has CAMHS support.

Gained consent to speak with school. Mark Rigby [DPA] Presfield High School.

Alphonse then said that he had phoned up last week and done a self referral with someone over the phone. Asked what he had asked for . He replied for council to help them . Explained that doesnt seem to have been put on the records yet.

Alphonse said that he had been told not to contact them again, they would contact him.

She had identified his anxieties which CAMHS will be addressing and also CAMHS having concerns over the loss of weight. Again discussed this is a health concern. If CAMHS have major concerns over his weight then he should receive support from a professional in that area. Cheryl said that father had phoned her and he wasn't happy how Samantha Steed at CAMHS had spoke about the weight loss as she had to him. Cheryl said that she had spoke to someone at CSC and had not been given the EHA template information to complete and was told to do as she had (see documentum). Cheryl asked if I would be able to transfer the information to the EHA form. explained that I wasn't able to do this. Discussed that she had completed a form and she could transfer the information to the EHA and discuss with Father the support he requires specifically as it doesnt seem clear as Axel is having support from CAMHS for his health needs and school need to address the attendance. Cheryl asked for the link to be sent to her by email, this was done. 26.5.2022@12:35 Return call from Cheryl Smith saying that she doesn't have a copy of the information that she sent previously to add to the EHA and could I please send it to her. Sent what she had sent through. She is unsure if she will have time to complete the EHA before half term. Will speak with father to identify what support is specifically required for Axel and if CFWS are the appropriate service. 26.5.2022@ 13:36 Phone call to father , Alphonse , [DPA] Explained that Cheryl smith from Presfield school will complete the EHA with him to identify what support is required and if CFWS are the appropriate service for this.
