Detailed Circumstances (Maximum 8000 characters) on October 2019, the accused was permanently excluded from RANGE HIGH SCHOOL, FORMBY. On 11/12/2019 at approximately 0910 hrs, MICHAEL MCGARRY, the Head Teacher of the school, was conducting a year 9 assembly. His attention was drawn to the accused inside the school premises. MCGARRY has approached AXEL and repeatedly asked the accused to leave, and began asking why he was there. The accused ignored MCGARRY and began to walk into the corridors of the school. Deputy Head Teacher Thomas DOLLY then saw the accused and MCGARRY walking down the corridor. It is alleged that the accused has then started to run, producing a hockey stick from inside his coat as he did so. In the corridor was a group of around 6 Year 9 pupils, one of which was the aggrieved. It is alleged that the accused has swung the hockey stick above his head, and then towards the group, striking the aggrieved on his left arm. MCGARRY has been able to restrain the accused from behind in a 'bear hug'. DOLLY has then taken the hockey stick from the grip of the accused. RUBAKUBANA was escorted to the head teachers office and police were called. Whilst waiting for police to attend, the accused is said to have been very calm and insistent that his actions were not wrong. It is alleged that the accused stated that he had attended the school to look for another pupil to attack. At 0935 hrs, Constable DODD attended the location. MCGARRY explained the circumstances to the officer. RUBAKUBANA stated to the officer he had a knife in his backpack. The officer searched the bag and located LD/02 -1 X KITCHEN KNIFE. MCGARRY passed the officer exhibit LD/01 - 1 X HOCKEY STICK. At 0945 hrs, Constable DODD cautioned and arrested RUBAKUBANA on suspicion of Section 47 assault, possession of a bladed article on a school premises and possession of an offensive weapon. There was no reply to caution. Intel has been received from PREVENT that AXEL is actively searching beheadings and other extremist material on his computer. It is also suggested that AXEL intended to kill a pupil at the school today, and that he was to do this by either beating him with a hockey stick or stabbing him if this not work. It is suggested that due to the pupil not being present, AXEL attacked another pupil randomly.

Notes Today Axel RUDAKUBANA has attended RANGE HIGH in FORMBY a school from which he is expelled from. He has taken a taxi to the school and has taken with him a hockey stick and a back pack with a kitchen knife in. Axel has attended the school to exact revenge on [REDACTED] as Axel believes he has been bullied by [REDACTED] in the past. Axel has not found [REDACTED] at the school as [REDACTED] is also currently expelled from the school. Axel not happy with this has ran at [REDACTED] and hit him three times with a hockey stick. Luckily [REDACTED] has reacted and covered his face with his arms so the attack has only resulted in reddening to his left arm and a small cut, he has also received painful fingers on his right hand. The headteacher has restrained Axel and taken him to an office to wait for police. On police arrival Axel has revealed he has a kitchen knife in his back pack and has been arrested sus section 47 assault, possession of an offensive weapon and possession of a bladed article and lodged at St ANNE STREET custody. It has later been found out that (a call from Police Officer in Sefton Paul Harrison who states he works with children in schools as part of terrorism PREVENT. He has expressed concerns relating to the DP doing internet searched for beheadings, school shootings and has the intent to kill another student. All this has been relayed to CJMHT and arresting officers to make contact in terms of safeguarding. His intention apparently was to kill the other student today with an adapted hockey stick and if that failed then he would use a knife. Fortunately this child was in today but dp assaulted another student with a hockey stick instead before admitting he had a knife in his bag. All details will be passed to SS and PVP in terms of supporting the dp.) There are obviously concerns regarding this male, the safeguarding of [REDACTED] who has no knowledge of the incident but the school will advise his parents of what has transpired today. The mental health team in custody are aware of this male and will assess him in custody.

Further concerns received regarding his reported viewing of inappropriate/violent extremist images. It is not yet known whether this has contributed to yesterdays attack. Whilst Axel sites bullying as a reason for wanting to attack the other pupil; it is concerning regarding the viewing of the extremist images and his intent to end the life of another YP. I am uncertain as to why this was not referred in at the time by involved services; however given the level of thoughts and violence shown it is felt this progress at level 4 to enable a swift multi agency response/risk assessment of the concerns. This meets level 4 on Lancashire's CoNR.
