Please provide a brief overview of work undertaken and progress made	Due to Covid-19 restrictions case to be closed until Axel returns to school and face to face direct work sessions can be offered. Step down to support family with social isolation and to ensure Axel has a school place. Due to Covid-19 restrictions social groups are not available at the moment, therefore the work around social isolation cannot be complete until these restrictions are lifted. TAF meeting held, Acorns have accepted responsibility for Axel and in turn have offered 1 hour per day with 1:1 specialist teacher, parents have taken the option to keep Axel at home for the remainder of this term, and for him to return in September. Due to Axel's ASD traits, he struggled to engage over video and telephone. Face to face work was to be facilitated through school to support with that transition, however as Axel is not returning until September the work would not be beneficial until the time. Alphonse has requested the support be closed until Axel is preparing to return to school, when it can be delivered face to face.

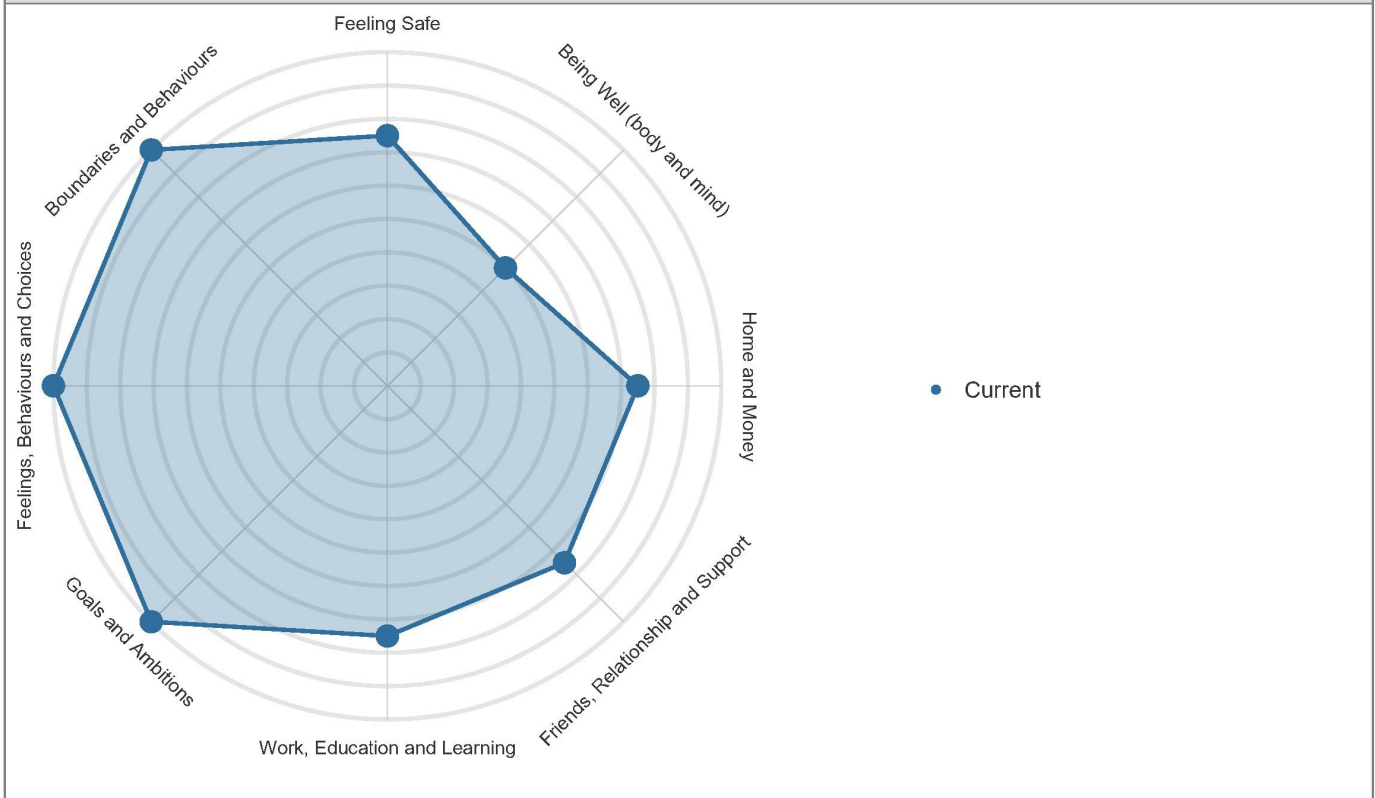

Our Family Notes

Feeling Safe	Alphonse feels safe at home, however there have been some incidents of drug dealing on their estate and police raids. Alphonse said the children do not play out or walk the streets unaccompanied so they are safe. Alphonse informed there is some historical bullying with Axel but he doesn't have those concerns now, although it worries him that Axel was able to take knives and weapons into school.
Being Well (body and mind)	Dion is a wheelchair user [DPA] and struggles socially, he does not have any friends and finds it extremely difficult to speak on the phone. Axel is suspected to be ASD and Alphonse is pursuing this as long with ADHD screening. Axel struggles with social circumstances. He presents as anxious when out in groups, or 'walking the streets'. No medical, mental or physical health needs in parents.
Home and Money	The family have lived in their current home sine 2016 and they are happy there. The boys have their own bedroom. The house is not specially adapted for wheelchairs. Alphonse has some credit card debts but says this is manageable, and said the family are just getting by. I asked if there was any financial hardship, Alphonse said no, but they would like a holiday which they can't afford at present.
Friends, Relationship and Support	Alphonse would rate relationships within the family as a 5, but external relationships and support would be a 2 Alphonse feels that he an Laetitia have good relationship with each other and the boys. There are no extended family close by. Alphonse said that he and his wife have some acquaintances from work who they would go for a drink with, but don't necessarily consider them friends. They had a group of friends from the same cultural community but that was prior to moving to Banks so they don't have that community anymore. neither Dion or Axel have friends. Axel had some friends but fell out with them. Alphonse says both boys are isolated and antisocial. They is just the 4 of them.
Work, Education and Learning	Both Alphonse and Laetitia work. Laetitia is still working as she is NHS staff, Alphonse is working as a taxi driver although he spends most of his time caring for the boys and is considering suspending work due to Covid-19, he tries to be flexible about the boys needs. Dion is going well at school there are no concerns with his education Following his permanent exclusion from school, Axel is currently on roll at Acorns, however Alphonse doesn't feel this is the most appropriate setting. Alphonse feels that Axel is learning and copying behaviours from other pupils and is not learning enough, he doesn't feel Axel is being pushed to reach his potential. Axel doesn't get on with his teachers, there are instances where Axel feels provoked by pupils (being pushed). They would like Axel to have an EHCP, and for him to be in mainstream education with support - eg a TA
Goals and Ambitions	Alphonse's main priority and goal is for Axel to be in school

Feelings, Behaviours and Choices	Alphonse feels that they can struggle with communication with each other, its easier with Axel than Dion, but he doesn't always understand their language or 'banter' and can think they arguing, but they aren't, although they do bicker from time to time Alphonse said the boys to not spend time together and have very different interests so are often doing different things in different rooms. Dion likes using the computer, Axel is mostly watching TV as his consoles were seized by the police following his arrest.
Boundaries and Behaviours	Axel can throw things on the floor and stomp slam doors when angry but this is infrequent. There is no physical aggression for either of the boys, but they are both stubborn and like things their own way. Axel can be argumentative with Alphonse, but responds well to negotiation and explanations. Both Follow the rules and there are consequences in place for when they don't.
