Re Axel Rudakubana DPA

Just to inform you that dad contacted CCT today. Dad reported that there have been a further two incidents this weekend. On exploration, Axel has not caused any physical harm but he has exhibited intimidating behaviour, verbal threats and on two occasions poured milk over dad. Parents felt able to de-escalate and manage the situation but admit it is now impacting upon family functioning. I've provided parents with advice and support, and it was agreed that this is primarily a social issue. Would you be able to contact family? I think it may be helpful for a multi-professional meeting considering that issues seem to be escalating in the family context.
