Have there been any big changes to the family situation you want us to be aware of?
No changes.

	What has gone well over the last year?	Is there anything that could be improved?
Education	Education has been a struggle and Axel hasn't been able to attend. Axel has only attended on 8 occasions.	I do not feel school fully meets Axel's needs and it was too much like a mainstream school, for children who want to attend school. I feel school could have done more to build a secure relationship and get him into school or engage him at home, or provide home learning. School only tried intermittently for 3/4 weeks. Axel found this annoying and a negative experience.
Health	Axel's anxiety has remained and has neither improved or declined, despite giving education a go. Axel's health has improved and he is eating better because of his visit to the dietician and has gained 15kg. Axel weighed 45.5kg in 23 May 2022 to 60.4 in December 2023. His medication has also changed and is now in liquid form so he will take this.	I would like to see Axel continue to put a little bit more weight on and maintain the current gain. I would also like to see his anxiety decrease and allow him to leave the house and access education more often.
Care	Myself and Axel are interacting better and there are less clashes between us. We are getting on much better. We have set boundaries and know one another's limits. We have an allocated social worker who will get in touch when he is 17 to support his transitions.	No.

What are your views about your child's/young person's progress over the last year towards the outcomes currently in their Education, Health and Care Plan?

Axel's progress towards his outcomes is incredibly limited due to the lack of education since the last review. I am disappointed with the lack of education and support provided, Axel has received nothing since July, I feel this is not good enough

Do you have any concerns?

I would like to see an appropriate setting named and Axel begin to make progress

I am also concerned about Lancashire SEND teams lack of communication. I have had to chase them for support and to make something happen, I have also been told people will come back to me and they do not. The inconsistency between email and egress is also incredibly difficult. In 5 months nothing has happened and it feels no one cares.

Do you think the content of the current EHCP reflects your child's/young person's needs? If not would you like to add or change anything?

I feel Axels latest EHCP (plan no3) describes him well and could be sufficient to meet his needs. I am incredibly concerned that an old EHCP (plan no2) has been used by current setting and miss represents Axel.

As your child/young person gets older, what are your wishes and aspirations for them as they become adults and what support do you feel is needed to help them move forward into adulthood and Independence?

Employment or training?

Yes I would love to see him get a job and be successful however first he needs to gain his people skills, crisis management skills, communication skills.
Axel is currently not ready for work but needs education in the form of life skills that he needs so that one day he can cope and fit in. I would like to see him become a functional member of the community and be able to manage difficult social situations with tact.

Independent living?	One day I would like Axel to be independent and be able to fulfil his own aspirations as per his one page profile.
Friends, relationships and participating in the community?	I would like Axel to have friends and improve his communication which he currently struggles with. I would like him to be able to cope and behave appropriately in social settings.
Health and wellbeing?	I would like his health to continue to improve particularly with regards to his weight.

Is there anything else that you would like to tell us about your child/young person, that we might find useful? I would like Axel to be assessed for ADHD however hit a wall when requesting support, my GP says it has to be school however he is not in a school so this cannot happen. Moving forwards, I would like Axel to get back into education. Axel wants to learn and study too. I am very interested in Peter house and the Flexi education programme they offer as I feel this could be supportive in meeting his needs and getting back into things. Since 1st September 2022, to date the Inclusion Team has not been responding to our concerns regarding Axel's being out of education and we are ignored by the LA. In fact, we have been abandoned by the Lancashire LA since September 2022. As a result, Axel has not have access to Lancashire home education nor has he found a new school that meets his needs because Presfield has clearly not been suitable for him. I would like to see this changed and the Inclusion Team improve their communication with us and actively seeks to help Axel with home education to prepare him for adult life and for Inclusion to be available when the education provider contacts them. It has been a shambles
