Non attendance due to repeated refusal to come to school. I have visited the house on numerous occasions to support the family and suggested various support such as reduced timetable and reduced hours. The 4 most recent occasions being the 3 weeks since the Easter Holidays, AR has not been present and parents have said that he was sat on the sofa but upon my knocking on the door he has quickly vanished and gone to his bedroom upstairs.

On 03/05/22 most recent visit, dad has been very reluctant in his approach to encourage AR to attend as he is not wanting him to be violent or trash the house. When he has asked AR to come down to say hi as an expectation of seeing the pupil to know that he is physically well, AR has refused. At the end of the meeting I have again asked dad to try one last time or if I could accompany him upstairs to quickly see that he is well to which dad has said no as he doesn't want AR to get angry and attack me. Dad has requested that I do a zoom meeting to see him but this is suggested at 7/8pm in the evening which is not suitable, then possibly 6.30pm as it takes mum an hour to get home from work. Mum is now working a day shift and has a good relationship with him and may be able to persuade him to come online as a family. Dad has shared that AR is openly refusing education as he doesn't see the point and thinks it's a waste of time as he would much rather learn about topics of interest. AR is accessing numerous platforms to learn about things that he is interested in as well as learning German, but it doesn't appear that there is any willing to want to sit the Summer Exams despite asking to be entered for these. Dad has said it doesn't look likely but we will see.
